

# NUCNAME - Name of Shared Nucleus

This Natural profile parameter specifies the name of the (environment-independent) Natural shared nucleus if it is to be loaded dynamically and not linked to the environment-dependent Natural nucleus.

**Note:**

The profile parameter NUCNAME does not apply under BS2000/OSD.

<b>Possible settings</b>	1 to 8 characters	Valid load module name.
<b>Default setting</b>	none	
<b>Dynamic specification</b>	yes	By specifying this parameter dynamically, you are able to use different Natural shared nuclei (for example, for production and for testing) together with the same environment-dependent Natural nucleus without having to relink the nucleus.
<b>Specification within session</b>	no	

The profile parameter NUCNAME is ignored if it is specified in a parameter string activated by a SYS or PROFILE profile parameter or in an alternative parameter module (as specified with the PARM profile parameter).
