

# CLEAR - Processing of CLEAR Key in NEXT Mode

This Natural profile parameter causes Natural to execute a specific Natural terminal command whenever CLEAR is pressed during program execution in NEXT mode.

<b>Possible settings</b>	any character	The default action can be overridden by supplying a character which, when appended to the terminal-command control character (as specified with the CF parameter), forms a valid Natural terminal command.  Example:  CF=% CLEAR=R  Natural executes the terminal command %R when the CLEAR key is pressed in NEXT mode.
<b>Default setting</b>	%	By default, when the CLEAR key is pressed, Natural responds as if the user had entered the terminal command %%.
<b>Dynamic specification</b>	yes	
<b>Specification within session</b>	no	

**Under Natural Security:** The setting of this parameter can be overridden by the Session Parameters option of the Library Profile.
