This documentation explains how to install Event Replicator Administration. The Data Mapping Tool is also installed using the installation procedure described here.

The audience for this documentation includes users who want to install Event Replicator Administration.

This document is organized as follows:

<i>Uninstalling Event Replicator Administration</i>	Describes the uninstallation steps for Event Replicator Administration in Windows environments.

1 Platform Coverage and Prerequisites

At this time, SAF-secured Replicator databases are not supported.

This chapter describes the supported platforms, database requirements, and the prerequisite Software AG products, for this version of Event Replicator Administration.

Supported Platforms

This release of Event Replicator Administration supports the same platforms as Adabas Manager. For more information, read *Platform Coverage and Prerequisites* in *Installing Adabas Manager*.

Database Requirements

Event Replicator Administration requires that all Event Replicator Servers be defined with the ADARUN parameter `NONDES` set to YES (nondescriptors are allowed in search buffers). This requirement does not apply to non-replicator targets accessed by Event Replicator Administration.

Prerequisite Software AG Products

If you want to use the Data Mapping Tool to generate GFBs and field tables, read *Prerequisites*, in *Data Mapping Tool User's Guide*, for a list of prerequisites for using the Data Mapping Tool.

If you want to use Event Replicator Administration to maintain replication definitions, please make sure that you have all the prerequisite products installed for Adabas Manager. Event Replicator Administration runs under Adabas Manager and has the same requirements. For more information about the prerequisite products for Adabas Manager, read *The Adabas Manager Environment* in *Installing Adabas Manager*.

2 License Key

Event Replicator Administration does not require a license key.

Steps to Perform Before You Install

Before you begin the installation procedures that follow, ensure that the following prerequisites have been met:

- Close all open applications.
- Disable any antivirus software.
- Ensure the target computer is connected to the network.
- Verify that the license key file has been copied somewhere in your environment or have the diskette available.
- Read the *Event Replicator for Adabas Release Notes* and the *readme.txt* file on the installation CD.

4 Installation Steps

The installation of Event Replicator Administration on Windows and UNIX systems occurs as part of the corresponding Adabas Manager installation. During installation of Adabas Manager, you are given the option of installing Event Replicator Administration. No additional license is needed.

If you have already installed Adabas Manager, but did not install Event Replicator Administration at the time, simply rerun the Adabas Manager installation, selecting the Event Replicator Administration component during the run.

For more information about installing Adabas Manager and Event Replicator Administration, read *Installing Adabas Manager*.

5 Uninstalling Event Replicator Administration

The uninstallation of Event Replicator Administration on Windows and UNIX systems occurs as part of the corresponding Adabas Manager uninstallation. During uninstallation of Adabas Manager, you are given the option of uninstalling Event Replicator Administration.

For more information about uninstalling Adabas Manager and Event Replicator Administration, read *Installing Adabas Manager*. The uninstallation information is provided within the individual Windows and UNIX installation sections of the documentation.



Notes:

1. Uninstalling will not remove any files that were not originally installed by the Event Replicator Administration installation tool. For example, files modified, expanded, moved, or introduced after installation must be removed manually.
2. Uninstalling will not remove any products you have installed manually, such as Natural Runtime or the special FNAT. To uninstall such products, run the uninstallation procedure a second time, but select the specific product you want to remove (such as Natural Runtime) instead.
3. Uninstalling will stop Event Replicator Administration.
