Apama provides CMF documentation in Eclipse Help format and in PDF. On Windows, to access the PDF files, select Start > All Programs > Software AG > Apama Capital Markets 5.3 > Documentation .

In addition, since the CMF is part of the Apama Platform for Capital Markets, you will want to refer to the Apama documentation set. On Windows, to access Apama documentation, select Start > All Programs > Software AG > Apama 5.3 > Apama Documentation.

Chapter 1: Preparing to Install CMF

Apama CMF 5.3 runs on the platforms listed in the Apama 5.3 Support Matrix available from a link on the following web page: empower.softwareag.com.

Memory, disk, and processor requirements for the CMF are the same as for Apama.

Before installing CMF, ensure that Apama 5.3 is already installed. Apama 5.3 includes compiler updates for both Windows and Linux. Be sure to read the topics in *Apama Release Notes* that describe the Apama 5.3 upgrades, in particular, "Migrating to Apama 5.3".

The following topics provide information about installing CMF on Windows.

Procedure for installing CMF on Windows

Follow these steps to install the Capital Markets Foundation on Windows platforms:

- 1. Download the Capital Markets Foundation distribution from Software AG's Software Download Center (SDC) in Empower at https://empower.softwareag.com and save it in a convenient location.
- 2. Extract the distribution package. The distribution package will extract to the following directory:
 - For 32-bit Windows: capital markets foundation 5.3.0.0 win 32
 - For 64-bit Windows: capital_markets_foundation_5.3.0.0_win_64

This directory contains both the installer and the set of PDF documentation for the Capital Markets Foundation.

3. Run the installer.

The installer creates shortcuts on the Start menu, creates a CMF Command Prompt, and configures the command prompt with the APAMA_FOUNDATION_HOME environment variable.

- 4. To verify installation, from the Start menu, choose All Programs > Software AG > Apama Capital Markets 5.3.
 - The Apama Capital Markets 5.3 folder contains shortcuts to ApamaDoc reference documentation, a CMF Command Prompt, a Documentation home page, and an ATA folder containing Algorithmic Trading Accelerator shortcuts.
- 5. To view the documentation, choose All Programs > Software AG > Apama Capital Markets 5.3 > Documentation. The documentation home page should open in a browser.
 - The Eclipse Help version of the Capital Markets Foundation Documentation available in Apama Studio offers several benefits over the PDF format. For example, Eclipse Help allows you easily search across multiple guides and documentation sets.
- 6. To confirm correct installation, run the Algorithmic Trading Accelerator. See the instructions in the *Algorithmic Trading Accelerator Guide*.

Installing CMF on Windows

Using Apama Studio to develop CMF solutions

On Windows platforms, you use Apama Studio to develop Capital Market solutions. When you install the CMF the installation script adds the APAMA_FOUNDATION_HOME variable and the CMF bundles to Apama Studio.

Uninstalling CMF on Windows

To uninstall the CMF on Windows Server:

- 1. Select Start > Control Panel > Programs and Features.
- 2. Select Apama Capital Markets Foundation.
- 3. In the Programs and Features menu bar, click Uninstall.

To uninstall the CMF on Windows 7:

- Select Start > Control Panel.
- 2. Below the Programs link, click Uninstall a program.
- 3. Select Apama Capital Markets Foundation.
- 4. In the top menu bar, click Uninstall.

Chapter 3: Installing CMF on Linux

Follow these steps to install the CMF to run server-side components on Linux machines.

- 1. Download the Capital Markets Foundation distribution from Software AG's Software Download Center (SDC) in Empower at https://empower.softwareag.com and save it in a convenient location.
- 2. Extract the distribution package. The distribution package will extract to the directory capital_markets_foundation_5.3.0.0_lnx_64_x86. This directory contains both the installer and the set of PDF documentation for the Capital Markets Foundation.
- 3. Run the installer, selecting the server components.

 If you cannot run the installer, try running chmod +x file_name in a command prompt to make it executable.
- 4. To run CMF processes, use a CMF command prompt with a configured environment. In a command window, enter <code>source APAMA_FOUNDATION_HOME/bin/cmf_env.sh</code>.

The Apama Studio development environment runs only on Windows. It does not run on Linux.

To uninstall the CMF on Linux platforms, enter the following command in a CMF command prompt:

APAMA_FOUNDATION_HOME/uninstall/uninstall_capital_markets_foundation_5.3
