

# TTYTYPE - Terminal Type

This Natural profile parameter allows you to specify the terminal type used - in TP environments in which this information is not supplied automatically - so that Natural can activate the appropriate converter routine for attribute sequences to operate that type of terminal.

<b>Possible settings</b>	1-4 characters	The setting specified with the TTYTYPE parameter must be defined as a valid terminal device type in the NTDVCE macro of the NATCONFIG module, see <i>Configuration Tables - Module NATCONFIG</i> .
<b>Default setting</b>	IBM	3270
	Siemens	The setting defined in PDN, unless overridden by the parameter T975X (see Natural <i>TP Monitor Interfaces, Natural under TIAM, Parameters in Macro NAMTIAM</i> ).
<b>Dynamic specification</b>	yes	
<b>Specification within session</b>	yes	The TTYTYPE parameter has the same function as the terminal command %T=.

## Anmerkung:

If you use the TTYTYPE parameter, it is no longer necessary to execute a program containing a SET CONTROL 'T= . . .' statement at the start of the session in order to set the terminal type.
