This command is used to check if the syntax of the source code currently in the editor work area contains any errors.

Mode	Reaction
Online	Syntax checking stops when a syntax error is detected, and the source-code line that contains the error is marked with \mathbb{E} in the corresponding editor.
Batch	Syntax checking continues until all statements have been checked, and all errors detected are included in the output listing.

Note:

Syntax checking is also performed as part of the RUN, STOW, CATALOG and CATALL commands.
