

Terminating the Global Swap Pool under UTM

This document describes the ways in which a Natural global swap pool can be terminated under UTM.

The following topics are covered:

- Termination Using Console Commands
- Abnormal Termination with Dump
- Termination by Program



Warning:

Before the swap pool is terminated, the Natural under UTM application that uses it must be terminated.

Termination Using Console Commands

▶ To terminate the global swap pool normally

1. Issue the console command:

```
/INTRtsn,STOP
```

2. or issue the console command:

```
/INTRtsn,END
```

Abnormal Termination with Dump

▶ To terminate the global swap pool abnormally, producing a dump

- Issue the console command:

```
/INTRtsn,DUMP
```

The swap pool is terminated abnormally and a dump is produced.

Termination by Program

▶ To terminate the global swap pool normally, using the program CMPEND

- Issue the following command:

```
/SYSFILE SYSDTA=(SYSCMD)  
/EXEC (CMPEND,NAT230,MOD) name
```
