

# SYSFILE

<b>SYSFILE</b> [ { <b>WORKFILE</b> } ] [ { <b>PRINTER</b> } ]
--

This command is used to invoke the `SYSFILE` function of the `SYSTP` utility. This function provides information on the work files and print files available.

Application Programming Interface: USR1007N. See *SYSEXT - Natural Application Programming Interfaces* in the *Utilities* documentation.

<b>SYSFILE</b>	If you enter only the command <code>SYSFILE</code> itself, work file <i>and</i> print file assignments are displayed sequentially.
<b>SYSFILE WORKFILE</b>	The work file assignments are displayed separately.
<b>SYSFILE PRINTER</b>	The print file assignments are displayed separately.
