

# %F= - Frame Characters for Window

```
%F=chv
```

With this terminal command, you can define the characters to be used in the frame of a window.

<b>c</b>	The first character will be used for the four corners of the window frame.
<b>h</b>	The second character will be used for the horizontal frame lines (top and bottom frame lines).
<b>v</b>	The third character will be used for the vertical frame lines (left and right frame lines).

Example: The command %F=+-! would cause the window frame to look like this:

```
+-----+
!               !
!               !
!               !
!               !
+-----+
```
