

# HAS-TOOLBAR

Determines whether the tool bar of a dialog (that is, the tool bar plus the tool bar items) is to be displayed or not. You use this attribute to dynamically switch the tool bar on and off.

**Note:**

The handle value of the tool bar must be assigned to the TOOLBAR-HANDLE attribute.

<b>Applies to</b>	Dialog (window, MDI frame, MDI child).
<b>Data Type</b>	BOOLEAN
<b>Default Value</b>	FALSE
<b>Possible Values</b>	TRUE / FALSE
