

# SUPPRESS-ENTER-CELL-EVENT

Determines whether or not the Enter-Cell Event will be suppressed for the dialog element. If it is suppressed, the event handler will not get control when the end user enters a cell.

<b>Applies to</b>	Column specification control, table control.
<b>Data Type</b>	I4
<b>Default Value</b>	0 (NOT-SUPPRESSED)
<b>Possible Values</b>	0 (NOT-SUPPRESSED) / 1 (SUPPRESSED)

**Note:**

You can use the symbols SUPPRESSED and NOT-SUPPRESSED defined in the local data area NGULKEY1. NGULKEY1 is automatically included in your application.
