This Natural profile and session parameter is used to enable or disable the use of dynamic thousands separators in edit masks at compilation time. At runtime the dynamic thousands separators are replaced by the value (thousands separator character) of the profile and session parameter THSEPCH.

- 1. In the Natural source, the dynamic thousands separator is either a comma (,) or a period (,), depending on the current setting of the profile and session parameter DC (decimal character). If a comma is specified, then the dynamic thousands separator is a period, otherwise it is a comma.
- 2. Fields in Unicode format should not be redefined as alphanumeric (A) or numeric (N) fields.
