

# WEBIO - Use Natural Web I/O Interface

This Natural profile parameter defines whether the Natural input and output (I/O) remains unchanged (i.e. terminal emulation in case of SPoD) or whether the Natural Web I/O Interface is used.

The Natural Web I/O Interface displays the input and output data in a web browser. On platforms other than Windows, it is only possible with the Natural Web I/O Interface to display and enter U format fields with characters which are not contained in the current code page.

The parameter WEBIO can only be used when Natural is running as a server, not in an interactive Natural session.

<b>Possible settings</b>	ON	I/O via Natural Web I/O Interface.
	OFF	I/O remains unchanged (terminal emulation). If the application is running on a Natural Development Server on Windows, this setting is ignored. In this case, the Natural Web I/O Interface is always used.
