About this Documentation

Natural Connection provides an access method required for transferring data, reports, Natural objects and sources from a Natural UNIX computer to a PC.

The prerequisite for the use of Natural Connection is Entire Connection. For information on Entire Connection, refer to the relevant documentation.

This documentation is organized under the following headings:

•	Main Functionality	Describes the main functionality that is relevant for UNIX.
•	Preparing to Use Natural Connection	Describes the tasks that must be accomplished to allow download and upload.
•	Natural Statements	Describes the Natural statements that are relevant for processing information between UNIX and the PC by using Natural Connection.
•	Processing Work Files	Describes restrictions on the use of work file attributes, the support of work file formats and the impact of READ loops.

Note:

Natural Connection is part of the Natural for UNIX installation; it is installed automatically when Natural for UNIX is installed.
