
## %X - Control of Infoline



This terminal command controls the display of the Natural infoline.

Command	Function
%X+	Switches the display of the infoline on.
%X-	Switches the display of the infoline off.
%X	Switches the display of the infoline on and off (toggle switch).
%XB	Displays the infoline in the bottom line of the screen.
%XT	Displays the infoline in the top line of the screen.
%Xnn	Displays the infoline on line <i>nn</i> of the screen.
	If the line number <i>nn</i> is not within the current screen, the infoline will not be displayed.
%X-nn	Displays the infoline on the <i>nn</i> th line from the bottom of the screen.
	If the line number - <i>nn</i> is not within the current screen, the infoline will not be displayed.

## Infoline

Data can be written to the infoline by specifying the output destination INFOLINE with the DEFINE PRINTER statement. Only a single line can be written to the infoline. The infoline can be used to have status information displayed, for example, for debugging purposes; it can also be used as separator line (as defined by SAA standards).
