

COMPR - Set RPC Buffer Compression

This Natural profile and session parameter can be used to set the RPC buffer compression. It is effective only, if the automatic Natural RPC execution is used (AUTORPC=ON) and the CALLNAT is executed without a stub. If a stub is used, the compression has already been set during stub generation. For details, see *Using Compression* in the *Natural Remote Procedure Call* documentation.

COMPR is specified on the client side only.

Possible settings	0	No compression will be performed.
	1	The send buffer contains modifiable fields and output fields and the format buffer. The reply buffer contains modifiable fields and input fields.
	2	Same as COMPR=1, additionally the reply buffer also contains the format buffer.
Default setting	1	
Dynamic specification	yes	
Specification within session	yes	The setting of this parameter can be changed using the GLOBALS system command.
