

# ML - Position of Message Line

This profile and session parameter specifies the line to be used for the display of applications which do not set the message line position explicitly by using the `SET CONTROL 'M'` statement. For information on the operand 'M', see also Natural terminal command `%M` (Control of Message Line).

**Note:**

The profile parameter does not exist in the Configuration Utility. Use session parameter `ML` instead.
