Using the Application Wizard

The Application Wizard is a tool which can be used as a simple alternative to the application workspace. You can use it to create, copy, rename and delete applications, to modify the description of an application, and to link/unlink Natural objects to/from an application.

To start the Application Wizard

1. From the **Tools** menu, choose **Application Wizard**.

Note:

This command is only available when the Application Wizard has been activated in the Plug-in Manager. See *Plug-in Manager* in the documentation *Using Natural Studio* for further information.

When an application server has not yet been connected, a dialog box appears first in which you have to specify the required connection information. See *Connecting to an Application Server* for detailed information on this dialog box.
