

ERASE

Description

Erase a file.

Syntax

```
ERASE path
```

path is as follows:

```
{[[drive:]\directory\...\]filename[.extension]}
```

Examples

- Erase the file *Test.ncp*:

```
ERASE Test.ncp
```

- Erase the file in the *SAG* directory which is determined by the contents of the variables #FILENAME and #FILEEXT:

```
ERASE C:\SAG\ #FILENAME #FILEEXT
```

- Erase the file *\SAG\Test.ncp* on the current drive:

```
ERASE \SAG\Test.ncp
```

Variables Returned

#RC (SUCCESS if ERASE was successful. FAILURE if ERASE was not successful.)
