Support of Db2 Version 13

This version of Predict supports Db2® Version 13. Several changes and enhancements have been made in various areas of Predict and its documentation.

License check for Predict with Natural for Mainframes

When running Predict with Natural for Mainframes version 9.2.2, a license check is performed. If your license does not exist or is outdated, Predict does not start.

Change in Company Name

The string "Software AG" has been replaced by "Software GmbH" or other text where it was used as a company name (for example, copyright information, error messages, hello screens, maps, etc. Where possible, the string was removed.

File Number Limit for Natural for Windows and for Linux and Cloud removed

This version of Predict has been enhanced to generate Adabas Files with file numbers up to 32000. It also supports file numbers for FDIC and FSEC up to 32000.

Extension of Files with type D and MT

- New Attribute PAGENUM
- Enhancement of attribute COMPRESS

New Attribute PAGENUM

The object type FILE has been extended with the new attribute PAGENUM. PAGENUM specifies the type of page numbering that is used when you create a partition-by-range table space.

Enhancement of attribute COMPRESS

The attribute COMPRESS now allows you to specify the additional values FIXEDLENGTH and HUFFMAN.

Extension of Dataspaces with type D

The attribute COMPRESS now allows you to specify the additional values FIXEDLENGTH and HUFFMAN.

Features Dropped with this Predict Version

The following features are discontinued and no longer supported in Predict Version 8.6.1:

Discontinued Support for Con-nect

The import and export function to a **Con-nect Document** as an external target for sources or text is removed with this version.

Discontinued Support for z/VSE and BS2000

Predict is no longer delivered for the operating systems BS2000 and z/VSE.
