- POJ-54 (was 1-1SBLDW)  
On a Linux platform, after installing webMethods Adapter for EJB 6.5.2, the EJB 3.0 services (Fetch EJB 3.0, Invoke EJB 3.0, and FetchInvoke EJB 3.0) fail.  
There is currently no workaround for this issue.
- POJ-55 (was 1-1SBMLW)  
On a Linux platform, after installing webMethods Adapter for EJB 6.5.2, an EJB XA connection is not enabled.  
There is currently no workaround for this issue.
- POJ-121  
When using the Adapter for EJB with WebLogic Server 10.3, a `java.lang.IllegalStateException` is thrown on the WebLogic Server side when executing an Adapter for EJB service or when browsing the JNDI tree. The exception does not impact the execution of the service or browsing the JNDI tree, and can be ignored.  
There is no workaround for this issue.

- **FetchEJB 3.0**  
Fetches a remote 3.0 EJB from those deployed on the application server.
- **InvokeEJB 3.0**  
Invokes and executes a method on a remote 3.0 EJB.
- **FetchInvokeEJB 3.0**  
Fetches a remote 3.0 EJB and executes one of its methods as a single service.
