- OFT-15
If Security Configurations are not defined for the wm.oftp.tn:deliverOftp service, Adapter 9.0 for OFTP does not use the default values defined in the Connection page of Integration Server Administrator.
To work around this issue, manually set the values of Security Configurations parameters before running the service.

- Adapter 9.0 for OFTP requires rvsEVO software and not the rvsXP software.
You must configure the rvsEVO server station, partner stations, private keys, and exchange certificates between the local rvsEVO station and partner stations, using the rvsEVO Administrator GUI.
- You must uninstall OFTP Adapter 7.1 before installing Adapter 9.0 for OFTP. Installing adapter versions 7.1 and 9.0 on the same Integration Server may cause conflicts when running adapter services.

You now use the *webMethods Installer* to install the adapter instead of using the manual method described in the documentation. Use the instructions below to replace the instructions in "Stage 2 Install the OFTP package" and "Stage 3 Install the OFTPforTN package."

About webMethods OFTP Adapter Packages

webMethods OFTP Adapter has two packages to be installed: OFTP (OFTP Gateway package) and OFTPforTN (OFTP for Trading Networks package). Where you install the packages depends on whether you are using a DMZ:

- If you are using a DMZ, install the OFTP package on the machine within the DMZ. This machine is referred to as the *OFTP Gateway*. Install the OFTPforTN package on the machine outside the DMZ. You will need to run the Installer on each machine, as described in the instructions below.
- If you are not using a DMZ, install both the OFTP package and OFTPforTN package on the same machine.

To install the webMethods OFTP Adapter

1. Download the webMethods Installer from the Empower website.
2. If you are going to install the adapter on an already installed Integration Server, shut down the Integration Server.
3. Start the webMethods Installer.
4. Choose the webMethods release from which to install the adapter. If you are installing the adapter on an existing Integration Server, choose the release that matches the release of that Integration Server. For example, if you are installing the adapter on a 7.1 Integration Server, choose the 7.1 release.
5. Specify the Software AG installation directory as the adapter installation directory. If you are installing the adapter on an existing Integration Server, specify the Software AG installation directory that contains that Integration Server.
The installer will install the adapter packages in the <IntegrationServer_directory>/packages directory.
6. In the product selection list, go to Adapters > webMethods OFTP Adapter 7.1, and then select the packages:
 - Select **OFTP** (if this machine is within the DMZ).
 - Select **OFTP For TN** (if this machine is outside the DMZ).
 - Select **OFTP** and **OFTP For TN** (if you are not using a DMZ).
7. Select and install any required webMethods products that are not already installed, such as webMethods Developer.
8. After installation completes, start the Integration Server on which you installed the adapter.
9. If you are using a DMZ, repeat steps 1-8 to install the remaining package on the appropriate machine.
10. Follow the instructions in the *webMethods OFTP Adapter Installation Guide* to configure the adapter.
