1. Connect to Apache Cassandra and MongoDB using JDBC Adapter with the relevant Big Data Driver rather than the individual adapter.

2. Connect to JMS providers using the native JMS capabilities of webMethods Integration Server rather than the JMS adapter.
3. Connect to Salesforce using the Salesforce connector provided with webMethods CloudStreams rather than the Salesforce adapter.
4. These adapters are available only if you have webMethods Trading Networks.
