If a product had service packs within a release, you can only upgrade the product from the latest service pack.

For some paths shown above, you cannot upgrade directly to the target release but instead must first upgrade to an interim release. Software AG recommends upgrading to the highest interim release possible because more automation is available with each release, and because upgrade is easier the closer the interim release is to the target release. For example, to upgrade from 8.2 to 9.12, you must first upgrade to interim release 9.0, 9.5. 9.6, 9.7, or 9.8, and 9.8 is the recommended interim release. For instructions on upgrading to each target or interim release, use the upgrade guide for that target or interim release.

As shown above, Software AG does not test or support direct upgrade paths from all 9.x releases to all newer releases; for example, direct upgrade from 9.0 to 10.0 is neither tested nor supported by Software AG. You might still be able to perform such upgrades, but be advised that you would be doing so at your own risk.
