If a product had service packs within a release, you can only upgrade the product from the latest service pack.

For some old releases shown above, you cannot upgrade directly to the new release but rather must upgrade to an interim release and then upgrade to the target release. To take advantage of automation improvements, upgrade to the highest interim release possible. For example, to upgrade from 8.2 to 9.12, upgrade to interim release 9.8 and then to target release 9.12. For instructions, use the upgrade guide for the interim release and then use the upgrade guide for the target release.

If a direct upgrade path is not shown above, Software AG does not test or support that path. For example, Software AG neither tests nor supports direct upgrade from 9.0 to 10.0 or later. You might still be able to perform such upgrades, but be advised that you would be doing so at your own risk.

There is no direct path from Presto 3.8 (webMethods release 9.7), Presto 3.8 (webMethods release 9.8), or MashZone NextGen 9.9 to MashZone Next Gen 9.12 or higher. Instead you must upgrade to MashZone NextGen 9.10 and then upgrade to the higher release.

Releases not shown above: Interim release for upgrade from 6.5 is sbs to 7.1 or 8.2. Interim release for upgrade from 7.1 is sbs or overinstall to 8.2, or sbs to 9.0 or 9.5. Interim release for upgrade from 8.0/8.1 is overinstall to 8.2 or sbs to 9.0 or 9.5.
