#### **New License Key Handling**

The license key format from version 9.6 and earlier is no longer supported. If you are logged on to Software AG's Empower site, you can request a new license key from Software AG Logistic Service Center (LSC). See License Key Concept.

#### **Publishing to CentraSite**

In earlier versions of ApplinX you could deploy ApplinX assets to a CentraSite installation that was not in the same machine as the ApplinX server. From this version, this is no longer possible; CentraSite must be installed on the same machine as the ApplinX server. See Publishing an Application to CentraSite.

### Features no Longer Supported from Next Version

The next version of ApplinX is planned to be based on Java 1.8, which no longer supports the JDBC-ODBC bridge functionality that allowed connecting to Access databases and ODBC data sources. This change will affect the following functionality:

- From the next version, external databases will no longer be supported as repositories.
- Currently (ApplinX 9.7 and below) MS Access (MDB) and ODBC (Microsoft) are supported without having to install additional drivers ("out-of-the-box"). From version 9.8, this will no longer be the case: you will need to install and configure additional drivers in order to use these database types with ApplinX. See also *Database Connection* for a list of supported database types.

Software AG provides ApplinX support for the operating/teleprocessing system versions supported by their respective manufacturers. In general, when an operating/teleprocessing system provider stops supporting a version of an operating/teleprocessing system, Software AG will stop supporting that operating/teleprocessing system version.
