1.0 Critical Information

 The Mobile Administrator build node functions incorrectly with the default Ruby for Mac OS X 10.9 (Mavericks).

When running on Mac OS X 10.9 (Mavericks), the Mobile Administrator build node for Mac OS X requires a more recent version of Ruby than the default version that ships with Mac OS X 10.9. The following issue in Ruby affects the Mobile Administrator build node: <u>https://bugs.ruby-lang.org/issues/9592</u>. This issue can result in various symptoms, which includes the build node printing an error to the build log. The error includes a Ruby system stack trace.

To reliably operate the build node, install at least Ruby 2.0.0p481 as the default system Ruby (not using RVM or rbenv). In addition, it is advised to upgrade the ruby gem 'libruby-xml' to at least version 2.7.0. Note that this issue does not affect earlier or later versions of Mac OS X.

MAD-2338

Deobfuscation does not work for Android crash logs.

You can upload Android crash logs to Mobile Administrator. However, deobfuscation using an uploaded Proguard mapping file does not work. Crash logs from obfuscated Android applications will appear obfuscated.

There is currently no workaround for this issue.

• MAD-2323

Crash log policy does not work for Android applications created with Mobile Designer. The crash log application policy for Android does not work with applications you create using Mobile Designer because of incompatibilities in the Proguard configuration that is provided with Mobile Designer applications.

There is currently no workaround for this issue.
