• WDA-101

On DB2 RDBMSs, the drop storage command in the Database Component Configurator does not drop the schema.

If you run the drop storage command for DB2 in the Database Component Configurator, it drops the tablespaces, tables, and views used by the database components, but it does not drop the schema.

Workaround: Drop the schema manually. For instructions, see the *Installing webMethods and Intelligent Business Operations Products* Guide.

• WDA-86

Command prompt appears and stays up for the entire time the GUI is open. There is currently no workaround for this issue.

3.0 Usage Notes

DB2 supports auto-resizing of tablespaces only in DB2 8.2 Fix Pack 9 and later versions. If you are using DB2 8.2 Fix Pack 9 or a later version, Database Component Configurator creates tablespaces with auto-resize enabled. If you are using an earlier version of DB2, you must resize your tablespaces manually.

• WDA-768

Database Component Configurator does not work with SSO/NTLM authentication when it is installed on Microsoft Windows. When you try to use the AuthenticationMethod as NTLM to establish a connection to Microsoft SQL Server, Database Component Configurator fails with the following exception: *Authentication was requested but the required DDJDBCx64Auth05.dll was not found on the path specified by the java.library.path system property.* Workaround: Add the following statement in the setEnv.bat file available at: <*Install_Dir*>\common\db\bin: set SSO=<Install_Dir>\common\bin set JAVA_OPTS=%JAVA_OPTS% -Djava.library.path="%SSO%" where <*Install_Dir*> is the installation directory.
