MOBILE-831

The Mobile Administrator Windows build node does not correctly detect and list installed versions of Mobile Designer 9.8.

As a workaround, place the Mobile Designer 9.7 style _Mobile_Designer_Changelog_ file into the Docs\ folder of the 9.8 installation of Mobile Designer. To make Mobile Administrator use and display the correct version, create a new entry for your Mobile Designer 9.8 version in the _Mobile_Designer_Changelog_ file.

MOBILE-38

Importing of apps fails with duplicate index key error message.

After exporting an application out of a Mobile Administrator instance, there might be an error when importing the exported package into another Mobile Administrator instance. The error message indicates a duplicate entry for a key.

There is currently no workaround for this issue.

Mobile Administrator 9.8 now uses the Software AG license key format. Please make sure to use licenses of the correct format when adding licenses.

■ WF-4652

Similar to the Mobile Administrator Mac build node assistant, the Windows build node now highlights and verifies steps you need to follow to install all SDKs and dependencies correctly in its very own setup assistant. Use the assistant to verify the setup of your build node is working correctly.

 If API consumers of Mobile Administrator, such as Software AG Designer Mobile Development, fail with a "Valid API consumer required" error message, go to the Maintenance menu and then to Cleanup Tasks > Create Default Objects. This will add the missing API consumers.
